The Delaware Riverkeeper Network (DRN) has filed a legal challenge in the U.S. District Court for the District of New Jersey of the decision by the Delaware River Basin Commission (DRBC) to extend, for a second time, its approval for the construction of the proposed Gibbstown LNG Export Terminal project on the Delaware River in Gloucester County, New Jersey.




The 2025 State of the Climate Report: The world on the brink
