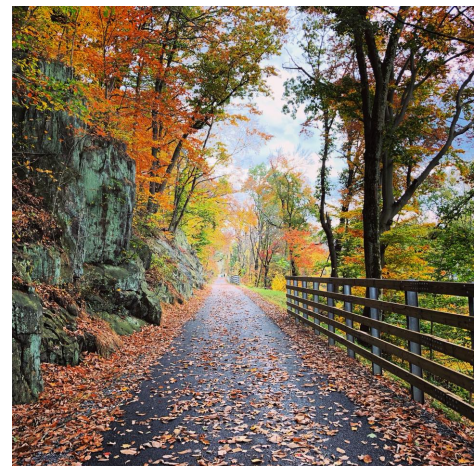


[Delaware County Cuts Ribbon on Chester Creek Trailhead Improvements](#)
